### NOVEMBER CONFERENCE BREAK CAMP

#### SEUSS STORIES Grades 1-5

### SHEL SILVERSTEIN

Grades 2-6

### SPRING BREAK CAMP

Once upon a time, Hans Christian Andersen wrote enchanting fairytales like *The Ugly Duckling*, *Thumbelina* and *The Emperor's New Clothes*. We will use creative drama to experience the exciting and touching adventures that make these fairytales timeless.

Grades 2-6

Can one person make a difference in the world? The uplifting play, *The Man Who Planted Trees*, will inspire our week of creative thinking, movement and puppetry. We will extend the arts experience with a visit to nearby Olympic Sculpture Park.
