Registration

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

How to Register:

- **Call** (206) 443-0807 ext.1186: Monday-Friday, 9:00am to 5:00pm. Please be prepared to provide the class number and class title, along with all of the other information requested on the registration form.
- **Mail:** Complete the registration form and send it to the address listed at the bottom of the form.
- **Fax:** (206) 443-0442.
- **Online:** WWW.SCT.ORG/CLASSES.
- **Registration Procedure:** All registrations are processed in the order in which they are received. Registrations for each class will be accepted until the class is full, or until the class begins, whichever happens first. Late registrations may be accepted after the first day of class on a case-by-case basis.

REGISTRATION POLICIES

CLASS SIZE

We maintain firm enrollment limits. Maximum class size ranges from 8 to 14 students, depending on the age of the students and the type of program.

PAYMENT

Full payment by check or credit card is required in order to secure your space in the class.

RETURNED CHECKS

A \$20 service charge will be attached to any check returned by the bank due to insufficient funds.

CLASS CONFIRMATION

Within a week after your registration is processed, you will receive an email confirming your spot in the class. Closer to the starting date of the class, you will receive more detailed information via email confirming class dates, times, location, and other general information.

CANCELLATION POLICIES

1. If you cancel your registration at least two weeks before the class begins, we will refund tuition less a \$25 registration fee per class. For full-day school break programs and the C.A.S.T. programs, the non-refundable registration fee is \$50.
2. If you cancel within the two weeks before the class starts, no refund will be given. Any tuition paid, minus the registration fee for the cancelled class, becomes a credit which you may use towards tuition for any Drama School class through Summer 2010 (registration must be received by May 28). Any lesser tuition costs from the new class will not be refunded. Students not attending the first two classes will receive no refund or credit.
3. Cancellation by SCT: We reserve the right to cancel a class if enrollment is insufficient. Any tuition paid will be refunded in full.
4. No refund or make-up classes will be provided for classes cancelled due to inclement weather. SCT Drama School classes will be cancelled on days that Seattle Public Schools are closed due to weather conditions.
5. We want all students to be satisfied with their experience at the Drama School. If, after attending the first day of class, you decide that you do not want to continue, let us know within

two business days, or before the second class, whichever comes first, and we will refund your payment (minus the \$25 or \$50 registration fee).

PRIORITY REGISTRATION

For Fall Semester students who want to continue in the same class for Winter Semester, we offer a priority registration period. The priority registration deadline is October 23. Until October 23, continuing students are guaranteed a place in the same class for the Winter Semester. After this date, no priority will be granted, and we will process all registrations from new and returning students in the order they are received.

ATTENDANCE

We expect students to attend every day of the classes in which they are enrolled, except in the case of illness.

DISCOUNTS

1. Multiple Class/Family Discount: We offer 5% off the total tuition (at a maximum of \$25) when you register for two or more classes within the same household. Multiple-class discounts are available only when you register for all classes at the same time.
2. SCT Subscriber Discount: If you subscribe to the Seattle Children's Theatre 2009 - 2010 Mainstage season, you will receive a 5% discount (at a maximum of \$25) off the full tuition price of any class for your student. This discount may be taken in addition to the multiple class/family discounts.

Note: Prorated Tuition is not available for late registrations.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

SCT Drama School offers financial assistance on three levels:

1. Need-based scholarships are available to families who would not otherwise be able to participate in our classes. An application is required; our criteria are based on the guidelines established by the Seattle Public Schools' free and reduced-price lunch program. Scholarships will cover between 20%-70% of total tuition.
2. Work-study positions are available each semester, providing parents and teenage students the opportunity to work for the theatre; often on administrative projects, as ushers, or classroom assistants; in exchange

for partial tuition. An application is required; families with greater financial need will generally be given priority for work-study.

3. Payment plans are available to anyone who prefers to split up their balance into two or three installments. No application is required; simply call the Drama School to make arrangements.

- September 1, 2009 for Fall Semester
- October 30, 2009 for November Conference Break
- November 16, 2009 for Winter Break
- December 14, 2009 for Winter Semester
- February 1, 2010 for Mid-Winter Break
- March 1, 2010 for Spring Break/Spring Mini-Session
