SEATTLE CHILDREN'S THEATRE CHAPERONE GUIDE

Just as many of our students are experiencing the theatre for the first time, many of our parents are experiencing their first chaperone experience at SCT. Please read this aloud to the chaperones or have them read it prior to attending.

Please read the following to chaperones before the field trip:

- When your entire group has arrived, you will be asked to make a single file line while we seat your class. Please do not leave the line until your whole group has been seated, as we need to make sure each person has a seat. Once your school group has taken a seat, you may rearrange in the seats assigned to your class. This is also the best time to use the restroom.
- As time is limited, please allow SCT staff to provide direction while seating students. Please note that the students you have been assigned to chaperone might be broken up during the seating process. Do not worry, you can reseat once the entirety of your group has been seated.
- The theatre is a communal experience and we encourage students to feel like they are a part of the show. We invite them to laugh, cry, smile, etc. However, we ask that you monitor your group's behavior to assist in the overall experience.
- Once inside the theatre, please turn your cell phones off. Photos and videos are not allowed of the stage, set or actors and taking either is a violation of US Copyright Law. Additionally, the light from your phone will distract the actors, stage crew and audience around you.
- Drinks with lids are allowed in the Theatre, but snacks must remain in the lobby. Your usher will direct you where to leave any non-emergency bags [lunches, backpacks, etc.].
